CAN YOU HELP?

Case #105 Carolyn has been helping animals in need for a long time. Now that she is on social security disability, she has not been able to get the last of her animals fixed. She has three female cats and two dogs that need to be done. SNAP's cost to fix her animals is \$345.

Case #106 David has two female Pit Bulls that someone left behind. He loves Pit Bulls and decided to keep them so he knew they would have a good home. SNAP's cost to fix the dogs totals \$180.

Case #107 Vickie has four male cats that need to be neutered and a male dog. She has three female cats that she had done several years ago on her own. In the last couple of years, the male cats have shown up and she has been feeding them. Since they are staying around, she would like to have them all neutered. The dog came from a friend who had to move and was no longer able to care for it. SNAP's cost is \$210.
