## CAN YOU HELP?

**Case #123** Kathi found out about three animals in a bad situation and decided she needed to help. She brought the three animals into her home and would like to keep them. The two male dogs, a Rottie mix, and a Pit mix are starting to show signs of aggression and the male cat is spraying. She is unable to afford the neutering cost without help. SNAP's cost to fix them is \$220.

**Case #124** Clarence has been living in west central Springfield for decades and has seen many stray cats in that time mainly from renters living in nearby apartments leaving them behind when they move out. He has helped as many as he can over the years but is no longer able to cover the cost. He needs SNAP's help with six young adult cats, four females and two males so they don't start reproducing. The cost for this group is \$320.

**Case #125** Gail is a single grandparent. She took in an older puppy from a friend who found a litter on the side of the road. She needs help getting her spayed along with three stray cats in her neighborhood. She is grateful for the help to assist these animals. SNAP's cost is \$230. assistance having all three fixed before there is another accident. SNAP's cost is \$270.
