Case # 37 –Kali is a 7 year old Terrier mix that Sheila's neighbor was no longer taking care of. Sheila felt sorry for the dog and offered to give it a good home. It is a smaller dog, black and tan and is now happy to be in a caring, loving environment. The cost to get Kali fixed is \$60.

Case #38 –Chris was not planning on getting any pets, but found two Boxer puppies in a situation where the owners were going to get rid of them "one way or another". Chris took them in and needs assistance getting them fixed before he has a house full. Freddy and Sparkle are brother and sister, six months old now and both fawn colored. SNAP's cost to get this dynamic duo done is \$160.

Case #39 –Cats, cats, and more cats! There is never a slow period for cats needing help. All the cats listed are strays that people have taken in but do not have the funds to spay and neuter. SNAP's cost is \$55 for a female and \$35 for a male.

- Mama, 2 year old female black and white short hair
- Bow, 1 year old male black short hair

- Minnie, 1 year old female calico long hair
