Case #129 Rochelle is a single mom who has taken in four dogs over the last couple of years that she found on the side of the road. She has done a good job of not having them get pregnant but has no extra money to get them fixed. She was very emotional when we said we could help. SNAP's cost to fix them is \$390.

Case #130 Seth lives in the country where animals are dumped frequently. He has four dogs and two cats that he has kept and has had several litters. A family member heard about SNAP, and he made the call. The puppies have now been placed with a shelter and he is overjoyed to be able to get his pets fixed. The 4 dogs and 2 cats will cost \$490.

Case #131 Florence lives in north Springfield where there are a lot of stray cats. She is on a very limited fixed income but saves up and has been getting them done one at a time. She heard about us recently and we are helping her get the last 5 females and 3 males done so no more babies in the Spring! SNAP's cost is \$420.
